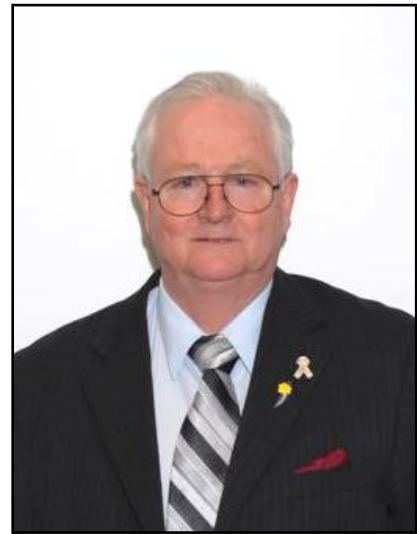


# NSW ANZFSS BRANCH LIFE MEMBER PROFILE

## Tony Raymond AM

Dr Tony Raymond AM has practised as a forensic scientist, both in the laboratory and in the field, since 1978. He graduated with a Bachelor of Science (Hons) from the University of Natal, South Africa, has a Graduate Certificate of Education from the University of Rhodesia, Zimbabwe, a Master of Science in forensic science from the University of Strathclyde, Scotland and a Doctorate in bloodstain pattern analysis from La Trobe University, Melbourne. His doctorate is titled "Trajectory Reconstruction from Bloodstains at a Crime Scene".

Dr Raymond has given evidence in a range of jurisdictions, including Zimbabwe, Victoria, Western Australia, the Australian Capital Territory and New South Wales, in relation to forensic casework. He was the principal scientist in the landmark Royal Commission of Inquiry into the Chamberlain Convictions and the McLeod-Lindsay Inquiry.

Dr Raymond is a past President of the Australian and New Zealand Forensic Science Society and past Chairman and current International Liaison Officer of the Senior Managers of Australia and New Zealand Forensic Laboratories network. He is also a member of the Australian Academy of Forensic Sciences, the Sydney Forensic Medicine and Science Network and a Fellow of the Australasian College of Biomedical Scientists.

He has held the positions of Director, Forensic Service Group and Chief Scientist of the New South Wales Police Force (NSWPF) and Director, National Institute of Forensic Science. He is currently the Chief Scientist for the Forensic Services Group, NSWPF and since June 2013, Tony Raymond has held the position of Manager of the Strategic Forensic Services Branch, NSW Police Force.

With a number of presentations, journal publications and book chapters to his credit, Dr Raymond consistently demonstrates his commitment to the advancement of the forensic sciences and the facilitation of leadership and forensic service delivery. Dr Raymond is an Adjunct Professor at the University of Western Sydney and an Honorary Fellow of the Australasian College of Legal and Forensic Medicine.

Dr Raymond was made a Member of the Order of Australia in 2010 for "service to forensic science in the field of law enforcement through the development of technological advances, including blood pattern analysis and DNA-related identification".
