Station Officer Morgan Cook (Churchill Fellow 2012)

Research Officer / Investigator with Fire & Rescue NSW

Morgan has been with Fire & Rescue NSW for 26 years having joined in September 1989 with his career including experience in Hazmat, Rescue, Communications, and the last 5 years being attached to the Fire Investigation and Research Unit (FIRU) as Research Officer and Investigator. Morgan is a 2012 Churchill Fellow after having spent almost 2 months travelling to other countries such as Sweden, China, Canada and the USA looking at how Fire Research influences and compliments Fire Investigation. Morgan was instrumental in orchestrating the research burns into the Quakers Hill Nursing Home Fire and is currently project managing the planning and construction of FIRU's new research facilities at Londonderry NSW. Morgan is a member of the International Association of Arson Investigators, National Association of Fire Investigators and is a serving committee member of the NSW Association of Fire Investigators.

GETTING THERE

LOCATION The Australian Museum is located on the corner of College Street and

William Street in central Sydney, just across the road from Hyde Park and

opposite St. Mary's Cathedral.

TRAINS The nearest train stations are St. James, Museum and Town Hall. Each are of

equal distance to the Museum and are an easy and mostly level seven

minute walk.

BUSES For bus services arriving in the city centre, alight near Town Hall or the

Queen Victoria Building and simply walk east along Park Street towards

Kings Cross – a seven to ten minute walk.

CAR PARKING There are three parking stations within easy walking distance of the

Museum:

<u>Secure Parking</u>, Riley Street (closes 11pm) <u>Domain Car Park</u>, St Mary's Road (closes 12am)

Enacon Parking, Cathedral Street (under Cook and Phillip Park) (closes

10pm)

Please enter the Museum via the Directors Entrance (halfway up the new entrance ramp on College Street) and follow the signs to the Long Gallery and through to the Hallstrom Theatre.
