Paul Dore, Juries Commissioner, has worked in the Victorian Public Service since emigrating from Montréal in 1994, first in the State’s Youth Justice System and for the last 11 years with Victorian Courts. Paul was the Supreme Court of Victoria’s inaugural Chief Operating Officer and on two occasions for extended periods, the Court’s Acting Chief Executive Officer.

Paul has been Victoria’s Juries Commissioner since March 2012.
