Roger is a casual lecturer to various forensic science courses around the world, and has a wealth of knowledge and experience of the law and a passion for forensic evidence. Roger became a lawyer in 1983, then transferred to the Army Legal Corps in 1984, and served in that Corps until retirement in 1999 in the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. Roger was awarded an OBE in 1995. After retirement from the Army Corps he engaged as a Tribunal Judge in the Asylum and Immigration Tribunal until retirement in September 2010. He now lectures in expert evidence for a number of forensic science programs in Australia and internationally.
